Teng Hoi Conservation Organisation	Invite current residents to join a Social Enterprise providing services for a variety of activities at the Blue House cluster. The activities would be developed in partnership with international and local schools and not-for-profit cultural organizations and could include street theatre, music and art performances, displays, and unique products for sale.
