活化歷史建築伙伴計劃

Revitalising Historic Buildings Through Partnership Scheme

在本計劃下,非牟利機構獲邀提交建議書活化政府歷史建築,使其能以創新的方法得以善用,成為獨一無二的文化地標,並鼓勵市民更積極參與相關保育工作。

獲選的團體將獲得政府資助,當中包括大型翻新工程費用,及每幢歷史建築最多五百萬元的一次性撥款,以應付開辦成本和最多在首兩年營運可能出現的赤字。此外,政府亦會收取象徵性租金。

第一期、第二期及第三期活化計劃先後於2008年、2009年及2011年推出, 而第一期「活化歷史建築伙伴計劃」旗下六幢歷史建築已陸續啟用,當中包括 預計將於2013年第四季營運的YHA美荷樓青年旅舍。

Under the Scheme, non-profit-making organisations are invited to submit proposals for selected Government-owned historic buildings to preserve and put them into innovative use, transform them into unique cultural landmarks, and promote active public participation in conservation.

Successful applicants are given funding support from the Government, which includes a grant to cover the cost of major renovation, and a one-off grant to meet the starting costs and operating deficits of the proposed social enterprise for a maximum of the first two years of operation at a ceiling of \$5 million per building. In addition, nominal rent will be levied for use of the historic buildings.

Batches I, II and III of the Revitalisation Scheme were launched in 2008, 2009 and 2011 respectively and the six historic buildings under Batch I have been in operation subsequently, including the expected opening of YHA Mei Ho House Youth Hostel in the 4th quarter of 2013.

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香港浸會大學中醫藥學院 — 雷生春堂 (雷生春)

Hong Kong Baptist University School of Chinese Medicine - Lui Seng Chun (Lui Seng Chun)

雷生春於1931年落成,樓高四層,原為雷亮先生家族所有,上層 為住所,地面為「雷生春」跌打藥店,是典型的「走馬大騎樓」 建築。在「活化歷史建築伙伴計劃」下,雷生春活化為中醫藥保 健中心,並於2012年4月正式投入服務。

Lui Seng Chun, a four-storey typical "Tong-lau" (Chinese tenement), was built in 1931 under the ownership of Mr. LUI Leung. Its upper levels were used as residence while its ground floor was a Chinese bone-setting medicine shop named "Lui Seng Chun". Lui Seng Chun was revitalised into a Chinese medicine and healthcare centre under the "Revitalising Historic Buildings Through Partnership Scheme". The centre came into operation in April 2012.

饒宗頤文化館 (前荔枝角醫院)

Jao Tsung-I Academy (Former Lai Chi Kok Hospital)

前荔枝角醫院依山而建,約於1921年至1924年年間建成,為長方型金字斜頂單層或兩層的紅磚樓房建築群。在「活化歷史建築伙伴計劃」下被活化為推廣中華文化及藝術的平台。設有展館的下區已於2012年6月啟用,而分別設有表演廳、餐廳的中區和旅館的上區亦將於2013年年底完工。

The Former Lai Chi Kok Hospital, comprising a cluster of single and double-storey rectangular pitch-roofed brick structures, was built along hillside between 1921 and 1924. Under the "Revitalising Historic Buildings Through Partnership Scheme", it has become a platform for the promotion of Chinese arts and culture. The Lower Zone (exhibition halls) was opened in June 2012 and the Middle Zone (performance venue and restaurants) and Upper Zone (hostel) are expected to complete their works by end of 2013.

Tai O Heritage Hotel (Old Tai O Police Station)

舊大澳警署建於1902年,屬19世紀晚期古典建築,充分融合中西建築元素,是一座富殖民地色彩的警署建築。在「活化歷史建築伙伴計劃」下,於2012年2月活化成共有九間套房的精品酒店,並附設文物探知中心供市民免費參觀。

Built in 1902, the Old Tai O Police Station is a vintage, colonial police station architecture of the late 19th century, fully integrating the architectural elements of the East and the West. The Station has been converted into a nine-suite boutique hotel under the "Revitalising Historic Buildings Through Partnership Scheme" in February 2012. Admission to its Heritage Interpretation Centre is free.

「芳園書室」旅遊及教育中心暨馬灣水陸居民博物館 (芳園書室)

"Fong Yuen Study Hall" - Tourism and Chinese Cultural Centre cum Ma Wan Museum (Fong Yuen Study Hall)

芳園書室建於1920至30年代,是馬灣唯一現存的戰前學校。書室屬一座兩層高的長方型建築,糅合中西建築風格。在「活化歷史建築伙伴計劃」下,書室於2013年3月活化成旅遊及教育中心暨馬灣水陸居民博物館,介紹芳園書室及馬灣歷史變遷。

Built in the 1920s to 30s, Fong Yuen Study Hall is the only surviving pre-war school on the island. The study hall is a rectangular two-storey building displaying a combination of Chinese and Western architectural styles. Under the "Revitalising Historic Buildings Through Partnership Scheme", the study hall has been converted into a Tourism and Chinese Cultural Centre cum Ma Wan Residents Museum introducing the historical development of Fong Yuen Study Hall and Ma Wan in March 2013.

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YHA美荷樓青年旅舍(美荷樓

YHA Mei Ho House Youth Hostel (Mei Ho House)

美荷樓於1954年落成,樓高六層,由一中央部分將相同的兩翼住宅單位連接而構成「H」型,為現時香港僅存的「H型」第一型徙置大廈。在「活化歷史建築伙伴計劃」下,美荷樓將於2013年年底活化成擁有129間客房的青年旅舍,並設有生活博物館,介紹深水埗及石硤尾區的歷史及早期公屋設計及生活環境上的特色。

Built in 1954, Mei Ho House is the only surviving Mark I "H-block" resettlement block in Hong Kong. It is a six-storey building characterized by two identical wings linked up by a cross piece forming the H-shaped plan. Under the "Revitalising Historic Buildings Through Partnership Scheme", Mei Ho House will be converted into a youth hostel providing 129 rooms and a livelihood museum which introduces the history of Sham Shui Po and Shek Kip Mei districts, the early public housing design as well as its characteristics of the living environment by end of 2013.
